**Utah Regional Ballet Presents New Original Works by Heather Gray  
and Alan Hinline, Renown New York Choreographer**

*Concert also features award-winning works  
by Jacqueline Colledge, Lily Bridgewater and Roxanne Gray*

**Sept. 29, 2010—Provo, UT**—Utah Regional Ballet, one of two professional ballet companies in Utah, today announced they will perform a collection of repertory works featuring Heather Gray, Utah Regional Ballet Mistress and resident choreographer, and Alan Hinline, renowned New York choreographer. Performances will be October 8 and 9, at the Covey Center for the Arts at 7:30 pm each evening.

In addition, Lily Bridgewater's original work, "Swayed Axis", winner of the Monticello Young Choreography Award at the Regional Dance America/Pacific Festival in Richland, Washington, May 2010 will be performed. The concert also features Roxanne Gray's work, "La Belle Vie", the Pre-Professional Division winner of Utah Regional Ballet's Choreography Design Project, last February.

"It is not often that audiences have the privilege of seeing original, award-winning works from nationally recognized artists," said Jacqueline Colledge, Artistic Director, Utah Regional Ballet. "We are especially thrilled to have Alan Hinline, a true professional in his field, return to Utah and work with URB.

Alan Hinline, New York based choreographer and Executive Director of Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet has staged and choreographed Sans Souci with music from Brahms Piano Concerto #2, an audience favorite.

The new contemporary work "As It Was" to be premiered by Heather Gray features the music of Arvo Part. Heather has received the National Choreography Plan award from Regional Dance America twice for her choreography. She has choreographed for Ballet West, Canton Ballet in Canton Ohio and South Bay Ballet in Torrance, California.

A new work by Artistic Director, Jacqueline Colledge entitled "Exit", is a neo-classical work for six women and one man. Colledge's piece "10 in Four Movements", recently won the National Choreographers Award at Regional Dance America/Pacific Festival 2010.
